Services Include:

- * Nutritious Meals;
- * Individual, Family, & Group Therapy;
- * Quarterly Reports;
- * Intake & Psychological Assessments;
- * Ongoing dental, medical, psychological, psychiatric treatment;
- * Community Activity Participation/Volunteer Opportunities;
- * Summer jobs (average summer savings \$450-\$550);
- * Outdoor recreation including camping;
- * Public school attendance with school-based volunteers;
- * Anger Management Classes;
- * Substance Abuse Education Classes;
- * Independent Living Skills Classes;
- * Life Skills Classes;
- * Parenting Classes;
- * Discharge planning and after care.

These services will be accomplished through trained staff, license psychologist, tutors and social workers. The primary counselor will monitor the client's progress daily and document progress in client's file.

Your child will be assessed based upon his: psychological, behavioral, emotional, and school performance, family relationships, court status and physical needs. Considering the child's past and present needs, the program admission staff, social worker, referring agency and guardian will jointly determine a treatment plan if Leatherwood's is deemed a suitable placement for your child.
